## Things you need or need to know:

- 1. INSTRUMENT in good working order. Remember all necessary accessory items mouthpiece, reeds, mutes, valve oil, etc. Bari sax players, bring your alto instead.
- 2. LUGGAGE. Each person may bring one suitcase, one small personal item (backpack), and your band instrument(s). The average high temperature for Orlando in March is 79 degrees; average low, 56. Bring a jacket or sweatshirt and an umbrella and raincoat. Bring comfortable shoes, obviously. Remember to bring sunscreen and maybe sunglasses and a hat.
  - a. Under seat item (One personal item). Must fit under the seat in front of you. Examples include a purse or backpack. H: 17", W: 13", D: 9"
  - b. Overhead/Carry-on (will be all small instruments). Must fit within the sizer box located at the ticket counter or at the gate. H: 24", W: 16", D: 11"
  - c. Checked (one suitcase for per person plus all large instruments). Maximum weight for checked bags is 50 pounds. Overweight checked bags are subject to additional charges. 62" Linear (length+width+depth)
  - d. Rules for Liquids:
    - i. For personal item (backpack): 3.4 OZ or smaller sized containers that fit in a 1 quart-sized resealable bag.
    - ii. For checked bag: Containers that are larger than 3.4 oz regardless of amount inside the container must be in checked baggage.
- 3. SWIM WEAR. We have optional pool time at our hotel. Bring a plastic bag in which to pack wet swimsuits.
- 4. MEDICAL CONCERNS. If you do not feel well, ask a chaperone or director for help. Any medications (over the counter and prescription) that you bring must be in original containers with complete labeling. If you have emergency drugs that you rarely use (inhaler, Epi-pen, etc.), please be certain they have not expired.
- 5. HOTEL ROOM. We suggest one person per room bring a power strip for charging cell phones at night. Leave game consoles home. Do not unplug cables from TV.
- 6. MONEY. Debit or credit cards are recommended. You will need money for souvenirs, two meals while traveling, and whatever snacks you require.
- 7. VALUABLES. We cannot guarantee the safety of items left in motel rooms. If you cannot keep it with you when leaving your room, don't bring it.
