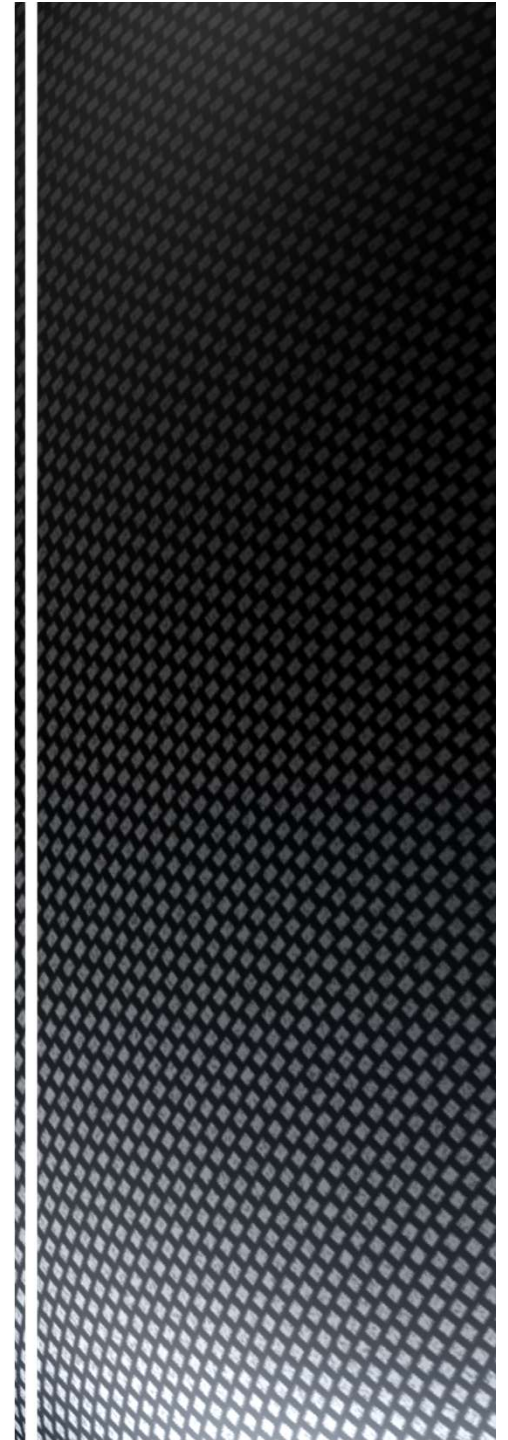

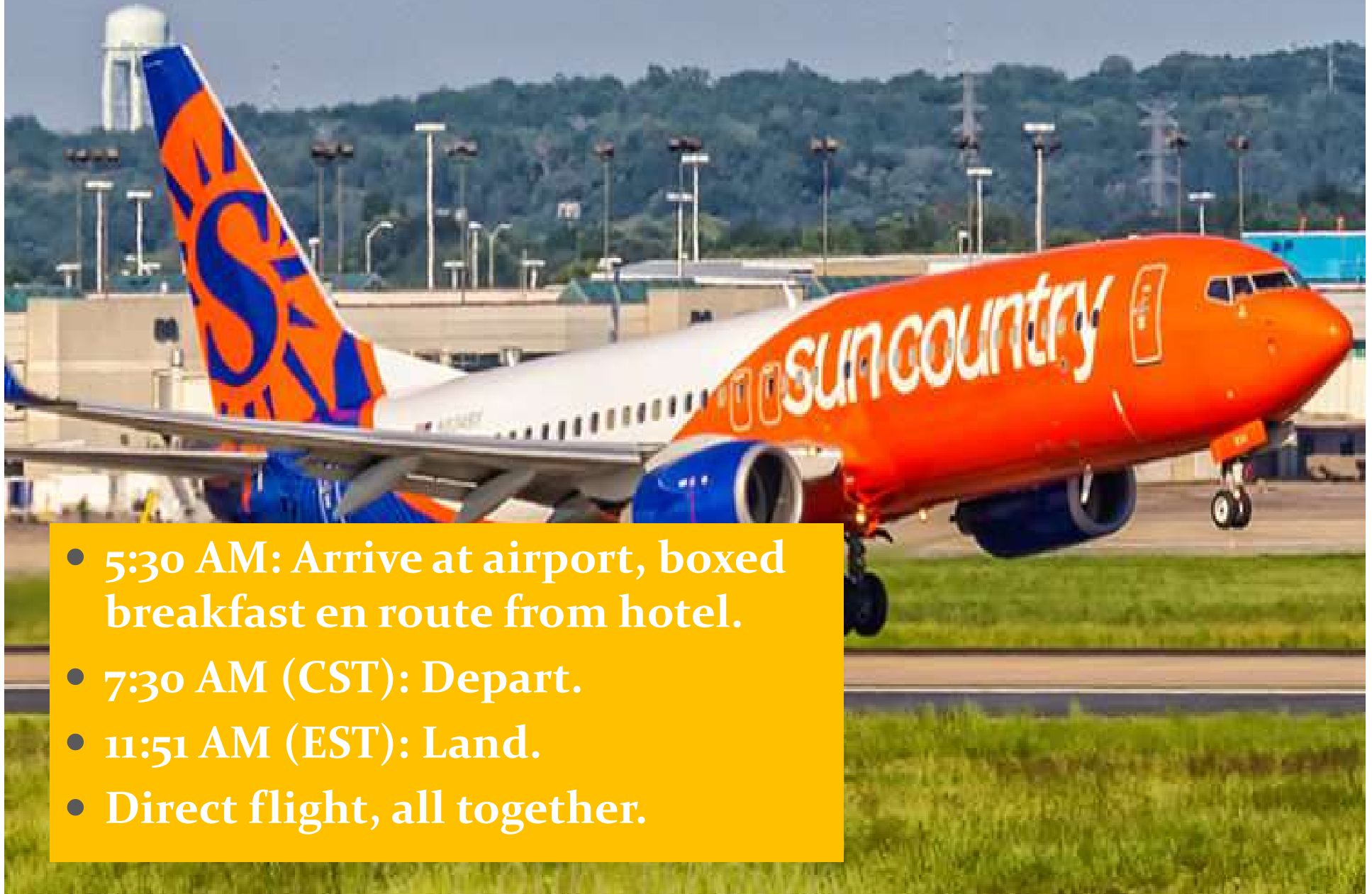
Saturday, March 9

- 2:00 PM: Load and Leave CF for Minneapolis
- 5:45 PM: Dinner at Mall of America.
- 8:30 PM: Arrive at Hotel: Hampton Inn, Eagan



Sunday – we're flying!

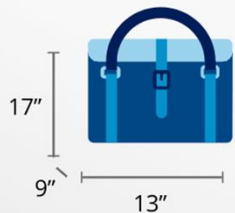
- 5:30 AM: Arrive at airport, boxed breakfast en route from hotel.
- 7:30 AM (CST): Depart.
- 11:51 AM (EST): Land.
- Direct flight, all together.



Sun Country Flight Details:

- Everyone gets one “Under Seat Item,” such as a backpack.
- Everyone will have one “Checked Item,” like a suitcase.
- The trip cost includes small instruments as an additional carry-on, large instruments as an additional checked bag underneath.
- **All bags, instruments, and suitcases must be labeled with an ID Tag. Please take care of this in advance.**

Baggage Sizing Guidelines:

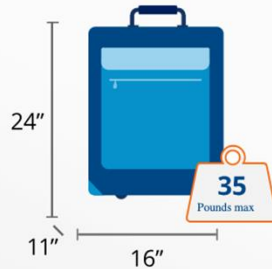


17" Height
13" Width
9" Depth

Under seat item

Must fit under the seat in front of you. Examples include a purse or backpack.

Personal Item



24" Height
16" Width
11" Depth

Overhead

Must fit within the sizer box located at the ticket counter or at the gate.

Small Instruments



62" Linear
Length + Width + Depth

Checked

Maximum weight for checked bags is 50 pounds. Overweight checked bags are subject to additional charges.

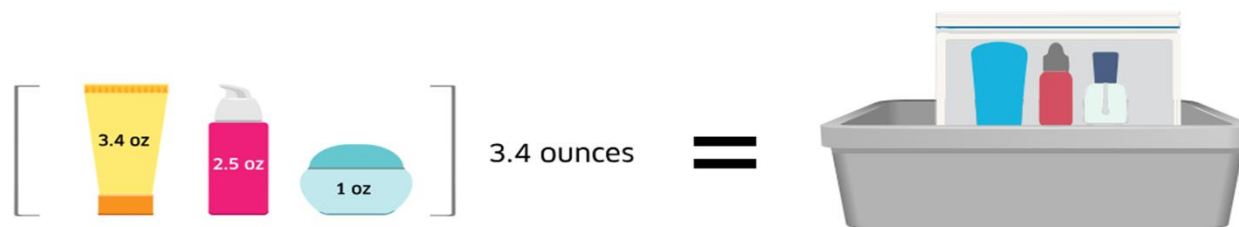
Large Instruments,

Liquids Rules:

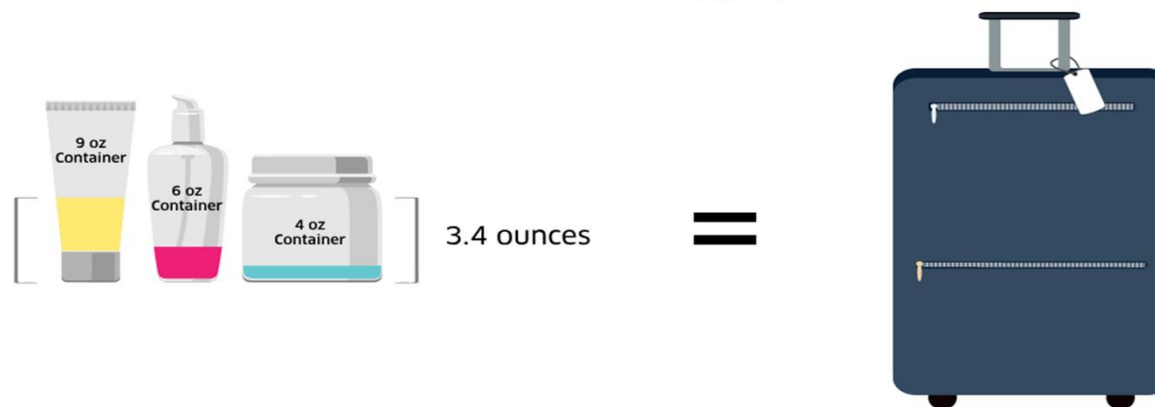
Carry-On Bag

3.4 ounces (100 ml) or smaller sized containers that fit in 1 quart-sized, resealable bag may go in carry-on and through checkpoint security.



Checked Bag

Containers that are larger than 3.4 ounces (100ml) regardless of amount inside must be in checked baggage.



Personal ID Card:

- TSA does not require children under 18 to provide identification when traveling within the United States.
 - Sun Country does not need an ID for 18 and under.
- All passengers 18 and older must show valid identification at the airport checkpoint in order to travel.
 - Please consult the TSA website for acceptable forms of ID.

Airport Security:

Please don't bring anything you shouldn't bring.

Airport Security/TSA will do a THOROUGH job of searching and scanning bags.

You may also be scanned/searched/patted down. Be courteous and professional.

While flying:

Do the seats have in-seat power?

- Most seats have USB charging ports. Some seats may also have AC outlets.

Are food and beverages available on the plane?

- Yes. Sun Country offers a variety of complimentary beverages, including water, coffee, juices, and soda.

Sunday: Land in Orlando, go to Epcot

- 2 PM until park closing: explore Epcot.
- Enjoy Spaceship Earth, Guardians of the Galaxy, Test Track, Mission Space, Soarin', etc. Fireworks at close.
- Meal coupons provided for lunch and dinner.





Rosen Inn at Pointe Orlando



Hotel: Rosen Inn at Pointe Orlando

- Temporary home for Sunday evening through Thursday.
- Breakfast each morning will be included.
- Uniformed security officers overnight from private security.
- Amenities include:
 - On site dining
 - Free WiFi
 - Gym
 - Pool

Hotel Rooms:

4 to a room when possible.

Students may not go in any other student rooms, regardless of gender (same policy as IHSMA for all-state). Only those names assigned to the room may be in the room.

Hotel Rooms:

Students will sign-up together for their rooms by birth gender.

Once they have a room figured out, they will fill out a sheet and turn it in to a director with names and initials next to each name.

Room signup sheets are due by Feb. 9.

Monday, March 11

Part 1: “*You’re Instrumental*” Workshop at Disney

- 5 AM: Early breakfast
- 6 AM: Depart for Clinic

Wednesday, March 13

- Breakfast at hotel, depart for Magic Kingdom
- Disney Day: 9 am to fireworks at park closing
- Lunch and dinner vouchers provided



Thursday, March 14– Back to CF

- 7 AM: Breakfast at hotel, check out of rooms, head to airport.
- 10:50 AM: Flight departs
- 1:29 PM: Arrive MSP, get luggage and instruments, load buses, head for home.
 - Fast food stop on way home.
- 6:00 PM: Arrive CF.



Trip Cost: \$1,569

- Must be paid in full prior to departure
- Band Boosters contribution: \$10,000
- Mr. Ramsey and Mr. Engelhardt are not paid to go on this trip: we are working on our spring break time.
- Chaperones are paying and working on their trip, too.

Medical Forms

- Need to be filled out completely and turned in.
- Turn in a sheet with a picture of the front and back of your insurance card with the student name on the sheet.
- Students are in charge of their medications – should be in original packaging (over-the-counter and prescriptions).
- If you have an inhaler or epi-pen, please make sure it's not expired.
- In the event of an emergency, a director will accompany a student to the hospital and immediately call parents on medical form. We will stay with your student the entire time.

School Trip = School Rules



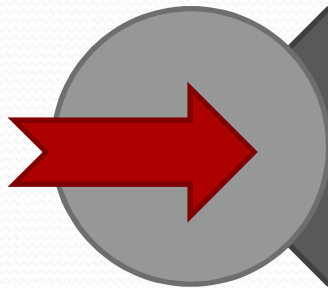
- At airports, Disney, Universal, and hotel, students will be under a lot of surveillance and need to behave.

- Sign and turn in behavior guidelines sheet tonight.



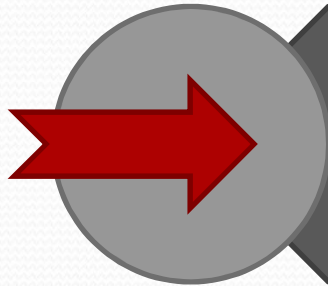
Wrap-up and questions

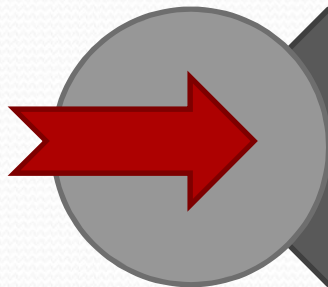
